

Taking steps to a fun day!

Step 1: Week of Sept 4 🍷 Pick up your donor envelope from school.

Step 2: Sept 6-Sept 21 🍷 Use your donor envelope to collect donations from your family, friends & neighbors. **Be sure to tell them that the money they give goes back to your school.**

Step 3: Friday, Sept 22 🍷 Turn in your Walk for Education donor envelope and donations to your school.

Step 4: Sept 27-29 🍷 Pick up your Walk for Education T-shirt, if eligible, from your school's Walk organizer. T-shirts are earned with a total of \$25 or more in donations; pedometers for \$200 or more.

Step 5: Saturday, Oct 7 🍷 Use the shuttle service to bring you to the start of the Walk—**McCorkle Place** (across from the Post Office on Franklin Street) starting at 1:30 p.m. Find your school's sign so you can walk with your school-mates. **Walk begins at 3 pm.** Remember—anyone can walk with us! Young children must be accompanied by an adult.

Free Shuttle

Shuttle service to and from the Walk will be available. Park your car at Culbreth Middle School or Phillips Middle School and take the bus to McCorkle Place. Buses to McCorkle Place will run every 15 minutes from 1 pm to 2:30 pm. Bus service will resume at Lincoln Center at 4 pm and run through 6:15 pm. Shuttles from Lincoln Center will go to Franklin Street, Culbreth Middle School and Phillips Middle School. Elementary age children must be accompanied by an adult. No pets allowed on the buses. Strollers must be collapsible.
